Job purpose

Reporting to the Senior Analyst: Legal, this is a specialist position, and the incumbent is expected inter alia to:

Key Responsibilities

- Assist the Commission in the performance of its core functions set out in Chapter 4 of the Competition Act.
- Investigate the impact of mergers and acquisitions on competition and certain public interest considerations, compile investigative reports as part of a team and / or independently and make recommendation to the Board of Commissioners.
- Receive instructions from supervisor to investigate the implications of competition law, other laws and decisions of the Commission in relation to mergers and acquisitions and provide findings accordingly.
- Receive instructions from the supervisor to research legal issues, provide findings and prepare non-binding legal advice and opinions to submit to superior for finalisation when required to do so.
- Investigate contraventions of the Chapter 4 of the Competition Act.
- Assist in drafting / review internal and external guidelines, policies and procedures relevant to mergers and acquisitions, and review the competition law.
- Recommend changes to the law in relation to mergers and acquisitions.
- Liaise with external legal experts to obtain advice as and when necessary.
- Conduct legal research for newsletter articles and draft the relevant articles.
- Assist with logistical arrangements for stakeholder's conferences (section 46 conferences).
